Keys for using the Camera RAW dialog box (Photoshop)

Result	Windows	Mac OS
Display highlights that will be clipped in Preview	Alt-drag Exposure or Shadows sliders	Option-drag Exposure or Shadows sliders
Skip file conversion when selecting multiple files (turn OK button to Skip)	⇧	⇧
Update RAW settings without opening file (turn OK button to Update)	Alt	Option

Keys for using Photomerge (Photoshop)

Select Image tool	A	A
Rotate Image tool	R	R
Set Vanishing Point tool	V	V
Zoom tool	Z	Z
Hand tool	H	H
Switch to Hand tool	Spacebar	Spacebar
Step backward	Control + Z	⌘ + Z
Step forward	Control + ⇧ + Z	⌘ + ⇧ + Z
More selected image 1 pixel	→, ←, ↑, or ↓	→, ←, ↑, or ↓

Keys for using the Layer Comps palette

Result	Windows	Mac OS
Create new layer comp without dialog	Alt-click Create New Layer Comp button	Option-click Create New Layer Comp button
Opens Layer Comp Options dialog	Double-click layer comp	Double-click layer comp
Rename inline	Double-click layer comp name	Double-click layer comp name
Select/deselect multiple contiguous layer comps	⇧-click	⇧-click
Select/deselect multiple discontinuous layer comps	Control-click	⌘-click

⌘=Command ↑=Up Arrow →=Right Arrow
⇧=Shift ↓=Down Arrow ←=Left Arrow

TIP! Need a quick way to process a selected group of Camera RAW images? Just hold down the shift key on the keyboard and double click on the selected images in the File Browser. The images will open up without the Camera RAW dialog appearing.
